

How to get from Prague airport to Novotel Wenceslas Square

Unfortunately there is **no direct metro or train connection** to the city, leaving public buses as the only budget transport option from the airport to the city centre.

It's a three steps process to get to the hotel: Bus - Metro - Walk

First: Take Bus No 119 to Metro station Dejvická





B: Buy a ticket at the Prague Public Transport ticket counter

You should purchase a ticket before travelling or, if arriving late and all shops are closed, buy a ticket directly from the driver — but note that large banknotes are not accepted. Prague Public Transport counters are located in the arrival halls of Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, open from 7:00 a.m. till 10:00 p.m. There are also coin-operated vending machines at each airport bus stop, or you can purchase your ticket directly from the bus driver. When buying a ticket from the

driver, please note that only cash is accepted (large banknotes are not accepted) and you will pay an additional surcharge.

Basic ticket: adults CZK 32 / children CZK 16; when purchased from the driver: adults CZK 40 / children CZK 20 – all tickets are valid for 90 minutes on any type of public transport.

When buying a 32 CZK ticket for public transport, you will receive a transferable ticket allowing you to travel for a 90-minute period. Note that if you are carrying any large pieces of luggage; e.g., a backpack or suitcase, you will need to purchase an additional half-price ticket (16 CZK).

C: Get on the bus No 119 direction "Dejvická"

D: Validate your ticket

Validate tickets immediately upon entering the vehicle. Use the ticket validation machines located on the holding poles near to the vehicle doors.

E: Get off the bus at the last station "Dejvická" and transfer to Metro Line A (Green Line)

Second: Take Metro Line A (Green Line) and get off the train at station "Muzeum"





Third: Two options to walk:

Option A: 10 minutes' walk to the hotel



Option B:

Take Metro Line C (Red Line) and get off at the next station "I. P. Pavlova" and walk four minutes from there to the hotel.

Note: you will have to walk first from station Muzeum-A to Muzeum-C to be able to access Metro Line C.
