
EUROPCOM 2015 FAR BEYOND THE AVERAGE

METHODOLOGY

- *Survey conducted by telephone (fixed-line and mobile phone)*
- Fieldwork: 3 23 September 2015
- Population: representative sample of population aged 15+ living in 209 regions (mix of NUTS I and NUTS II)
- *Coverage: 28 EU Member States*
- Total number of interviews: 62,511
- This survey was carried out for the European Commission (Directorate-General for Communication, "Strategy, Corporate Communication Actions and Eurobarometer" Unit)




ECONOMIC SITUATION IN THE REGION (1/4)

% answering "Good"*





















percentage points difference 2015-2012






Q2.1 Expectations for the quality of life in the region



Q3 What do you think are the two most important issues facing (OUR REGION) at the moment? (% - EU)



















Q4 Trust in the European Union










Q5.2 The best placed to explain how European policies impact citizens' day-to-day life

% answering "Members of the European Commission"












% answering "Your (NATIONALITY) political representatives"











