## Content

The EUNET Youth Committee (YC) has planned for a training course meeting the needs of young professional educators busy in the field of European Youth Education. The YC will organize this training, which will provide new insights into recent educational developments.

Training seminar topics will deal with the refugee crisis, which is currently testing the EU's core values (solidarity, unity, diversity). We are currently facing that these values are under threat. We want to explore how exactly we can tackle the current situation in a fair and unprecedented way together with European youngsters.

We want to delve deeper into the methods of simulations and drama games to spark emphatic education that does not rely on cognition but fosters sensual involvement.

Along the lines of debriefing and evaluation we want to deal with supervision, group motivation, building of confidence, creation of positive learning atmospheres and educational room design.

We also want to touch upon the organisational / logistic side of our work (the dark force), thus we will have closer looks at funding possibilities.

As members of the EUNET network a training course will also offer the chance of getting in touch with educators from all over Europe and share best practise experiences, as well as meeting partners for future projects.

These different aspects of educational work are possible topics and contents that we think are of importance for most of the members of the EUNET network and those who are actively conducting and planning projects.

## Feedback

There will be daily evaluations to find out about individual feelings, the group atmosphere and the status of the agreed aims of the project. There will also be time and place for criticism and new ideas.

## Methods

Non-formal learning methods and digital learning tools. All methods are designed to activate the participants. The methodical repertoire is orientated on the target group and shall support the engagement with the topic. The aim is that participants will do many things by themselves and that they try things out. It is important to have a high variation of methods to keep the programme interesting and exciting and to cover the different needs of all participants.

## Questions concerning programme and organisation

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## Conditions

Participation fee: 150 € (please bring cash)

EUNET will cover your travel cost up to a maximum of 250€. (Reimbursements will be made by bank transfer after we have received the required documents from you.)

In detail:

- It is required to use the cheapest means of travel, and to make every effort to use the most economic fare.
- Use of a private car will be reimbursed with 0,22€ per kilometre (regardless of the number of people travelling in the same vehicle). A maximum of 1600 kilometres in total will be accepted.
- Second class train ticket
- Economy class air fare (please keep boarding cards and include them in your documents).
- For rental cars (maximum category B or equivalent) or taxis: the actual cost where this is not excessive compared with other means of transportation. (please include a written and signed comparison with other transportation in your documents)
- Credit card fees for flight tickets will be reimbursed if you prove that no cheaper way of payment had been possible.
- Extra charge for baggage will be reimbursed.
- Parking fees at railway station or airport cannot be reimbursed.
- Costs for meals during the travel cannot be reimbursed
- Travel cancellation insurance and baggage insurance cannot be reimbursed
- Fees for seat reservation cannot be reimbursed.
