

How to get from Malta airport to Hotel LeMeridien

There are **three options** available to get you from the airport to the hotel: bus, shared shuttle bus or private cab.

You could claim the ticket for **public transportation** or the **shared shuttle bus** in the travel cost form to get it **reimbursed by EUNET** (within the 250€ maximum).

Costs for a **private cab** (taxi) **will not be reimbursed** by EUNET.

Public Transportation



Public buses are the cheapest form of transfer from the airport to the hotel.

It's a **three steps** process to get to the hotel: **Bus - Bus - Walk**

How to purchase a ticket?

You can purchase your tickets on the bus from the **driver** or buy them at the **information desk** inside the main Arrivals area at Malta Airport or from one of the **tickets machines outside**.

These Cash **Tickets** are Single Journey tickets that can be used to get to any destination within two hours, **including interchanging**.

The **price is 1,50€**

Information Desk:

As you walk through to **main Arrivals lobby** at the airport from the Baggage Reclaim area, you will see the **Malta Public Transport Information Desk (open 8h to 19:30h)** in front of you. If you require any information about the bus services that are available from the airport or would simply like to pick up a few timetables, you will find all the information you need at the desk.

First: Take Bus No X1 to Cirkewwa

A: Get to the bus stop “Airport 3”

The **bus** service runs from just outside the Malta International Airport terminal, **across the road from the Departures Hall**. Walk to bus stop **Airport 3** (within the main bus terminal).

Watch out! Vehicles are driving on the left (wrong) side of the road!

The bus departs roughly **every 45 minutes**, depending on the time of the day.

B: Get on the bus No X1 direction “Cirkewwa”

You will have to stay on the bus for 8 stops. The trip takes 29 minutes.

Don't get nervous if you follow the trip on your GPS system and the bus gets you away from the hotel.

C: Get off the bus at the bus stop “Pembroke Park + Ride 2”

Don't get confused. There are four bus stops named Pembroke Park + Ride - 1 to 4. There is only one Pembroke Park + Ride on your line, even if it has number “2” in the name.

D: Walk to the bus stop “Pembroke Park + Ride 1”

Pembroke Park + Ride 1 is just across the street in the direction you just came from.

Second: Take one of the following bus lines:

13 or 16 direction Valletta

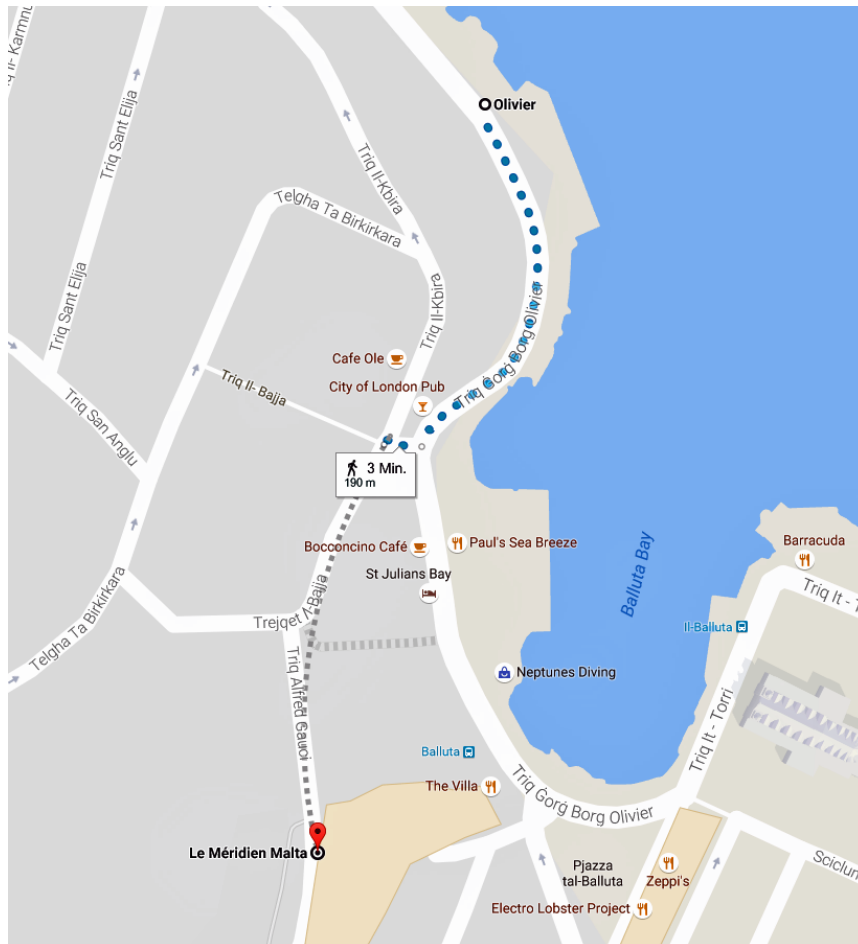
212 or 222 or 225 direction Sliema

It doesn't matter which one you take. Just take the one which arrives first. You don't need a new ticket. The bus will go in the direction you came from – that's correct.

Get off the bus at the bus stop “Olivier”

The number of stops between Pembroke and Olivier varies from line to line. The trip takes between 5 and 6 minutes.

Third: 3 minutes' walk to the hotel (190 meters)

Shared Shuttle Bus



The company maltatransfer.com offers a **shared shuttle bus** to get from the airport **directly to the hotel**.

The **price is 8€** for the one way trip to the Hotel LeMeridien.

The **duration** of the trip **depends** on the number and location of the hotels the bus will go to first, before reaching the LeMeridien.

It's recommended that you make an **online reservation** on the website <http://www.maltatransfer.com/> for the shared shuttle bus.

The vehicle will leave at the time stated on your Transport Voucher. **If you have been delayed, on arrival please enquire at the maltatransfer.com desk, in the Luggage Reclaim Area**, to organise transport on the next available Scheduled Shared Transfer.

For sales, assistance and information you may visit their **office** at Malta International Airport **situated in the baggage reclaim area**.

Once you exit into the **arrivals lounge** **follow the signs on the left**, at the corner near the Bank of Valletta office you will find the **waiting room** from which eventually the driver will lead you to the transport vehicle.



Private Cab (taxi)

The company maltatransfer.com also offers **private cabs** to get from the airport **directly to the hotel**.

The **price is 19€** for the one way trip to the Hotel LeMeridien.

It takes roughly **30 minutes** to get to the hotel.

It's recommended that you make an **online reservation** on the website <http://www.maltatransfer.com/> for the private cab. The reservation will be **linked to your flight number**.

Please keep in mind that the **costs for a private cab will not be reimbursed by EUNET**.
